**DAYS OF PRAYER AND FASTING**



Fireplace Kids,

As our community enters into a time of praying, fasting, and seeking God, I want to remind you of two of our core values here at Fireplace Church - Devotion to Jesus and Empowering the Next Generation. God wants to empower YOU, the next generation, with the Holy Spirit through your pursuit of and devotion to Jesus.

The next 3 weeks is a time where every person at Fireplace Church, kids included, are being invited to surrender things we like, exercise discipline to pursue God, and connect with Him daily in a real and tangible way. For the kids specifically, we want to emphasize studying God's Word, prayer, and worship as their avenues to God.

David once sang a worship song to God. One of the lines said this:

“One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple.” - Psalms 27:4

Did you know that though David most likely wrote this as an adult, he showed the same desire for God when he was a kid? David used to look after his family's sheep. He was often alone in the wilderness while he took care of them. Do you ever get bored when you are alone? David did too.

Can you guys guess what He did? He would talk to God and play him music on his lyre (a small stringed instrument). From a young age God saw David seek Him when no one else was around.

God knew that David loved Him because He spent time with God. God could see the purity of David's heart. God would soon honor David's pursuit of Him by anointing him as King of Israel.

Over the next 3 weeks, each of us have a daily opportunity to spend time with God by talking to Him about our lives, asking Him for help, studying the Bible, and worshiping Him. We can do it in many different ways. The important thing is that we do it.

Just like we show discipline every day in brushing our teeth, making our beds, and taking care of our bodies by drinking water and eating food, we can also show discipline in spending time with God. In fact, why not pray to God in your head while you brush your teeth or worship him while you make your bed or read your Bible while you eat breakfast!? You can be creative. David spent time with God while he was outside looking after sheep. You can invite God into every activity you do.

May God bless your time with Him over the next few weeks and throughout your life. May this time of seeking Him be the beginning of a life of a disciplined, daily pursuit of God. God is excited for you.

# DAY 1

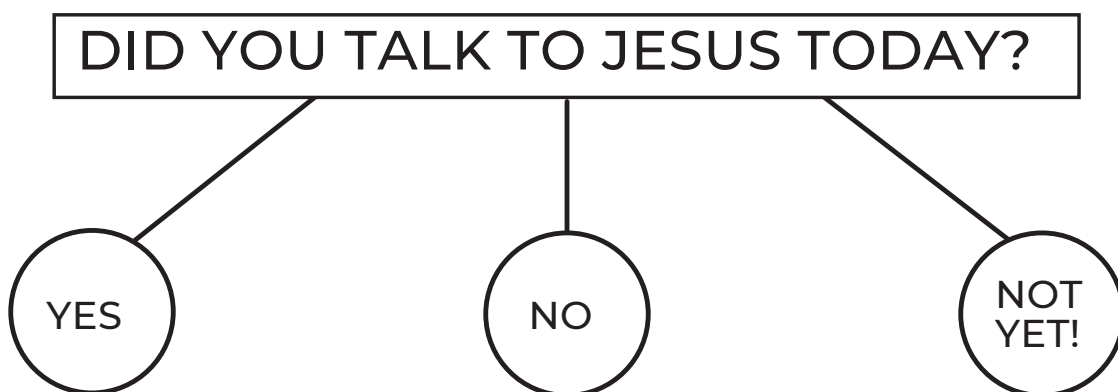
*Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where He prayed. (Mark 1:35)*

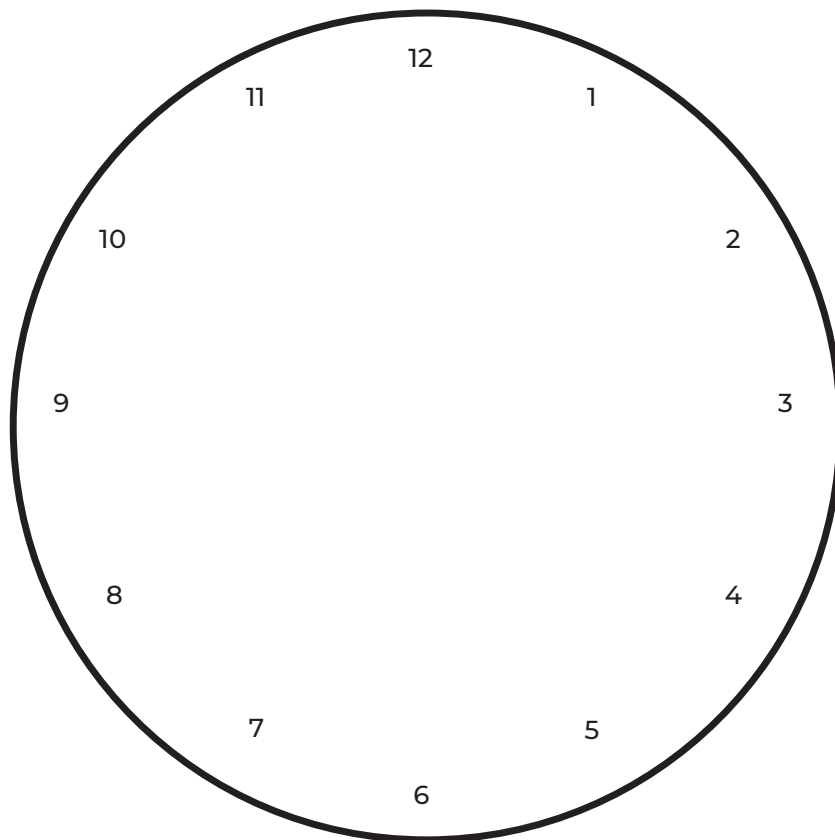

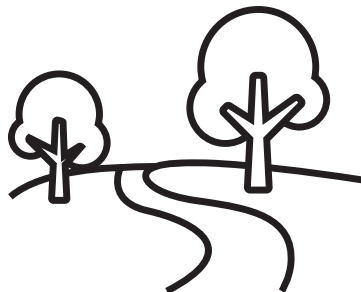
## 2. PLACE

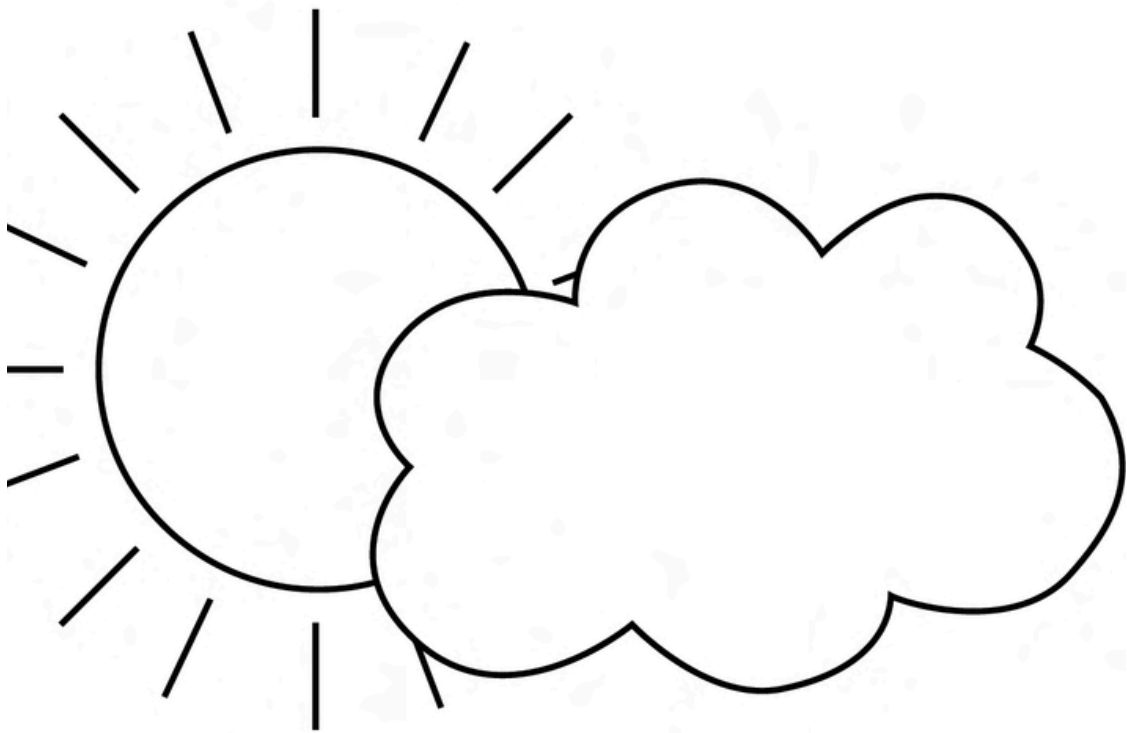
## DAY 3

(Matthew 6:9-13 NKJV)

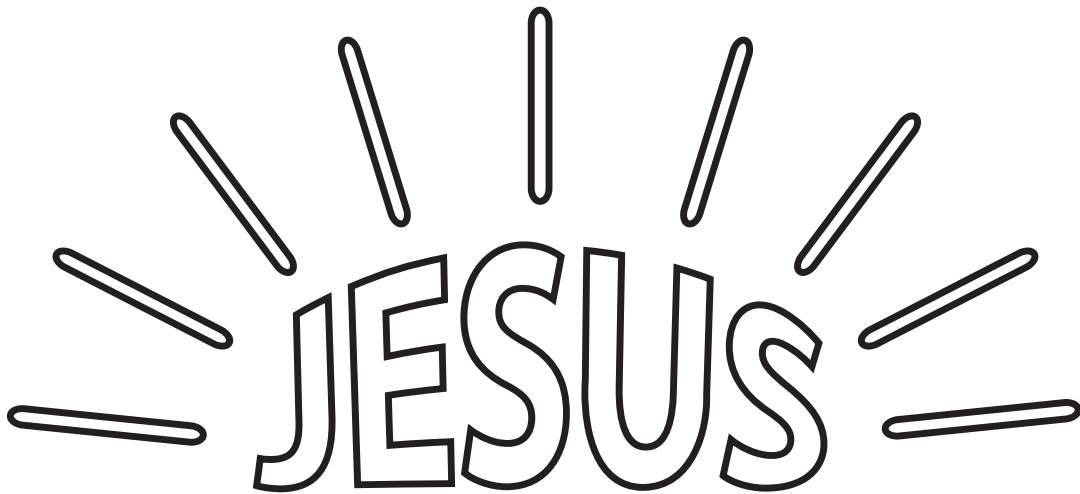

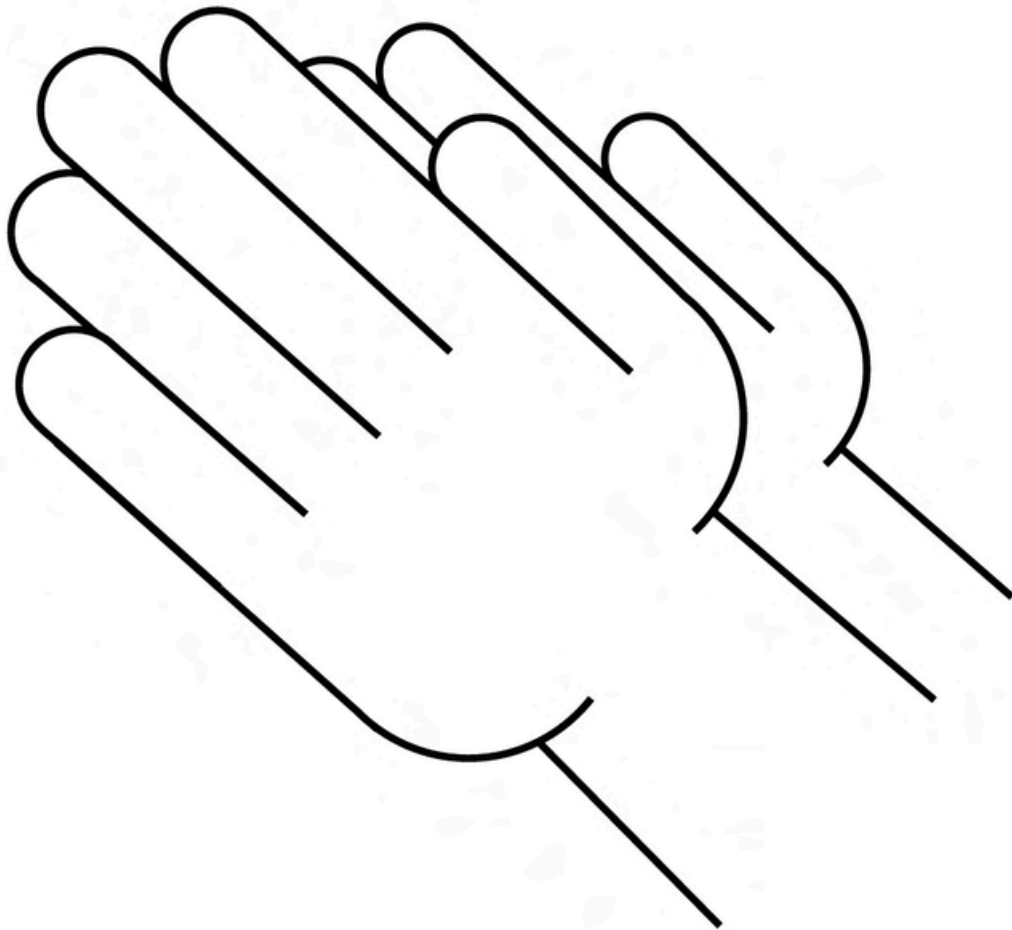

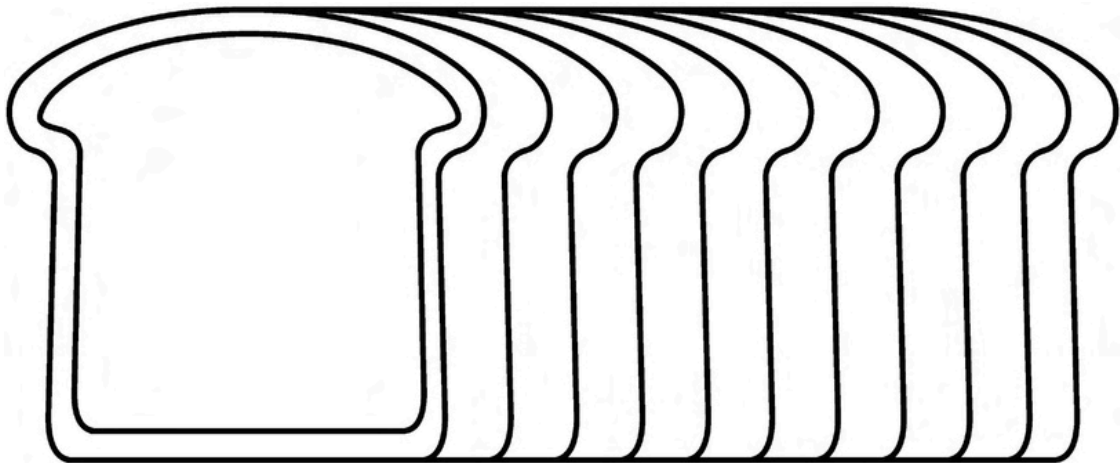

then trust Him to provide for you.

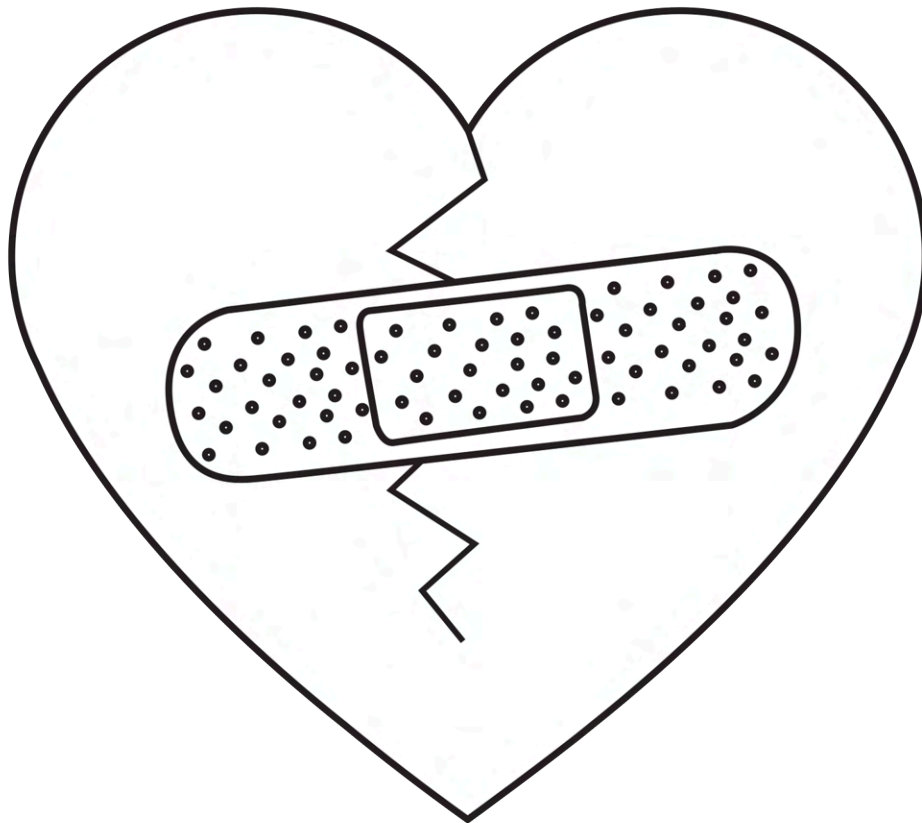

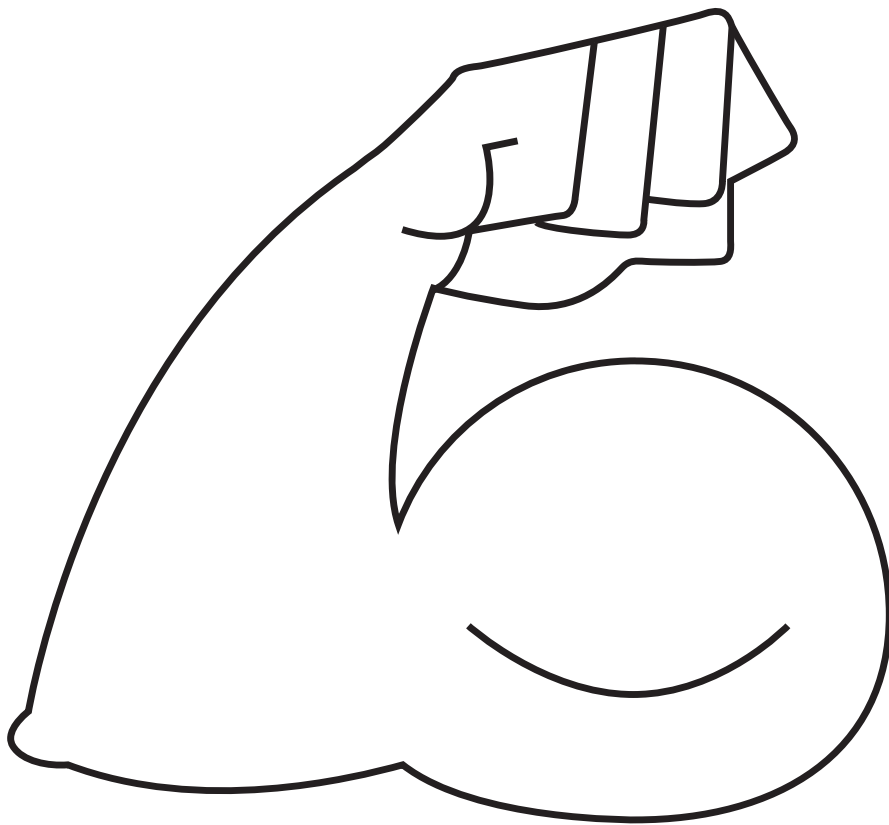

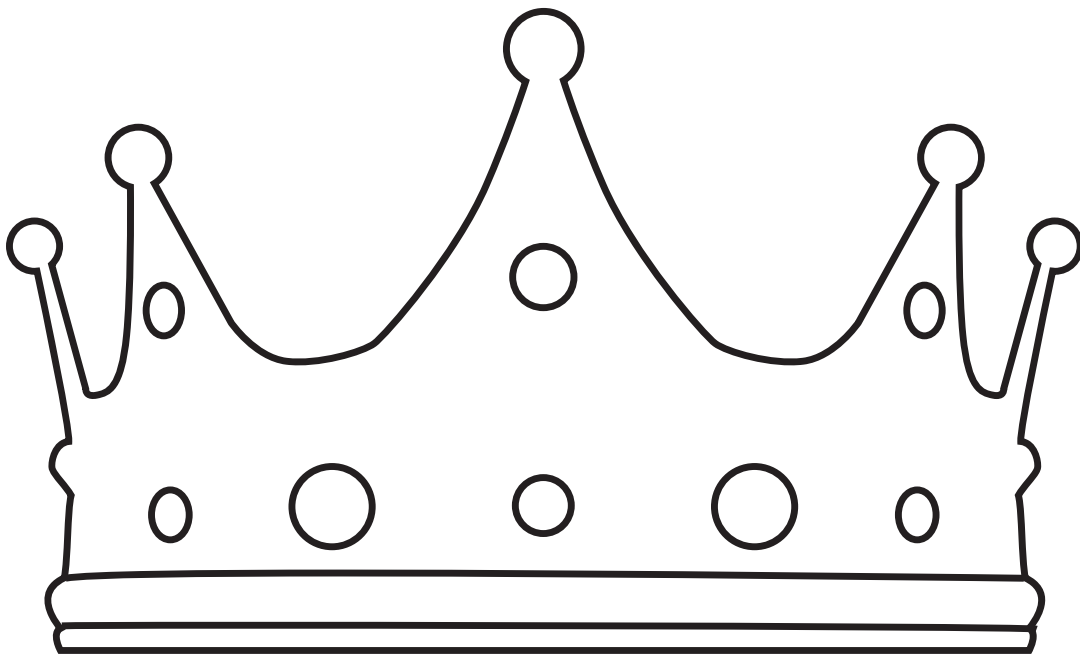

Have you ever been lost and not know where you were going? It's not a fun feeling.

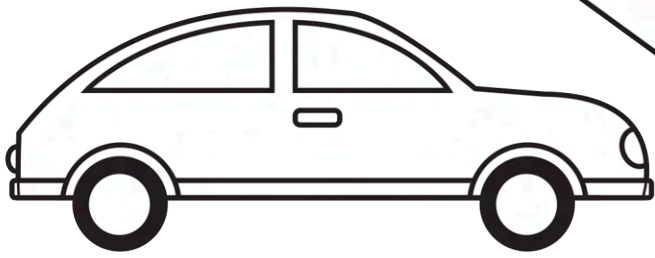
The easiest way to avoid this is to ask for directions from someone with a map.

# PRAYERS FOR WHEN I NEED HELP

## DAY 12



Pray through the Armor of God.

Read Ephesians 6:11-18 and then say a prayer to God like the one on the next page to put on your armor!

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore, put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the **belt of truth** buckled around your waist, with the **breastplate of righteousness** in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the **gospel of peace**. In addition to all this, take up the **shield of faith**, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the **helmet of salvation** and the **sword of the Spirit**, which is the Word of God. And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people."

*(Ephesians 6:11-18)*

On my arm, I will carry the **shield of faith** and block the attacks from the evil one. I know God is with me.

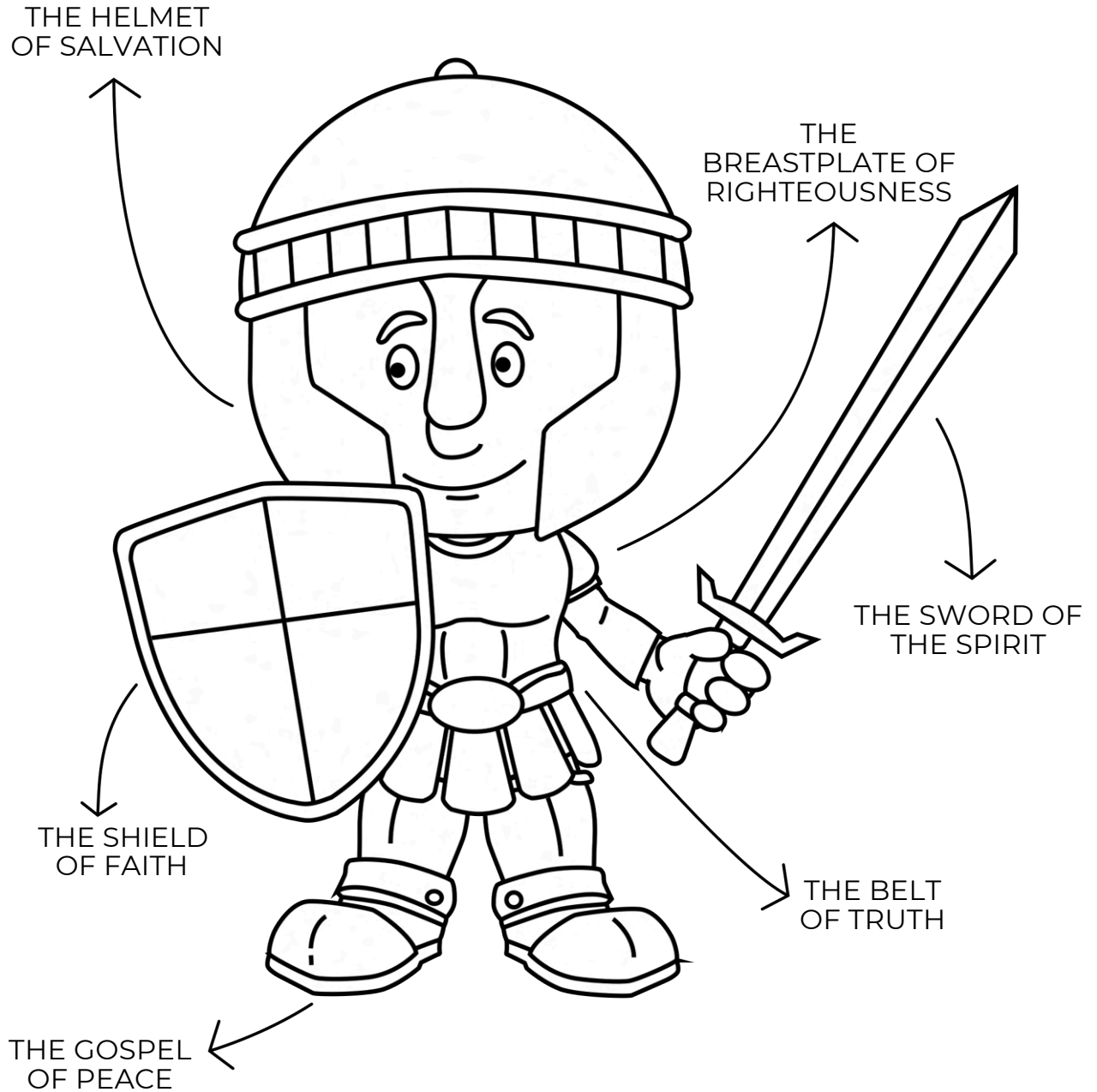
On my head, I will wear the **helmet of salvation**. Jesus loves me and I belong to Him!

I ask that you would give me peace, perfect love that casts out fear, and complete confidence in You.

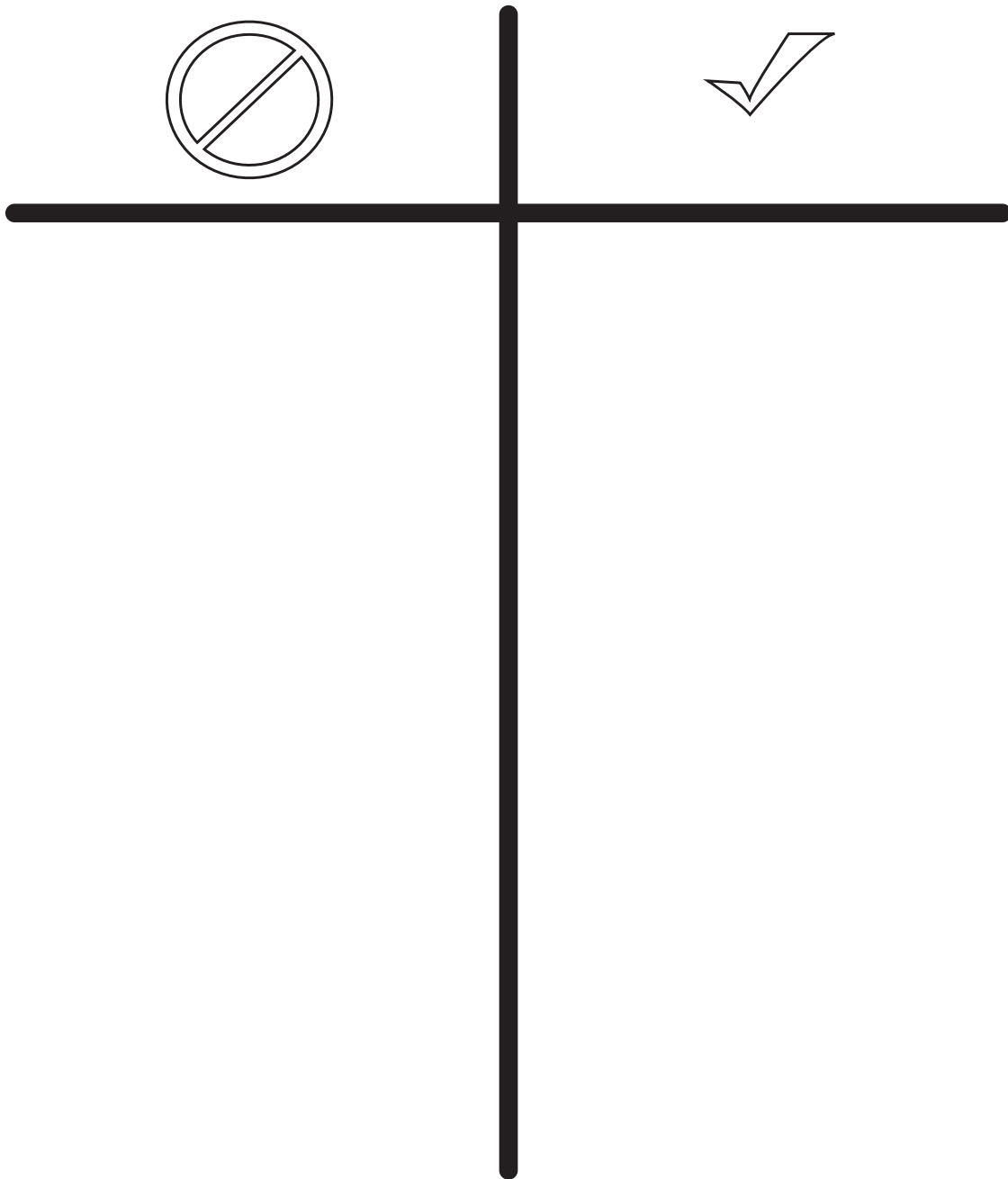
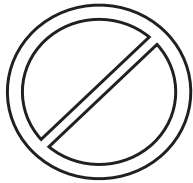

# DAY 16

There are three great things we can use to protect ourselves.

## 1. THE NAME OF JESUS

Jesus tells us that He will protect us and keep us. He will cover us with His wings. The Bible says that the name of the Lord is a strong tower that we can run to so we can be kept safe.

## 2. THE COVERING OF THE BLOOD OF JESUS

When Jesus died on the cross for us, His precious blood was shed. And that blood saved us, washes our sin away, and protects us.

## 3. THE WORD OF GOD (THE BIBLE)

The Bible is full of prayers of protection. It is such a powerful weapon against the enemy. We can pray God's Word over us and our family. Psalm 91 is one of those great prayers of protection.

I run to the name of Jesus, my strong tower.

Thank You for being my rock and strong defender.

Read Psalm 91 out loud when you are finished praying.

## Psalm 91

- 1 Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High  
will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.[a]
- 2 I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress,  
my God, in whom I trust."
- 3 Surely he will save you  
from the fowler's snare  
and from the deadly pestilence.
- 4 He will cover you with his feathers,  
and under his wings you will find refuge;  
his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.
- 5 You will not fear the terror of night,  
nor the arrow that flies by day,  
6 nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness,  
nor the plague that destroys at midday.
- 7 A thousand may fall at your side,  
ten thousand at your right hand,  
but it will not come near you.
- 8 You will only observe with your eyes  
and see the punishment of the wicked.
- 9 If you say, "The Lord is my refuge,"  
and you make the Most High your dwelling  
10 no harm will overtake you,  
no disaster will come near your tent.
- 11 For he will command his angels concerning you  
to guard you in all your ways;  
12 they will lift you up in their hands,  
so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.
- 13 You will tread on the lion and the cobra;  
you will trample the great lion and the serpent.
- 14 "Because he[b] loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him;  
I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.
- 15 He will call on me, and I will answer him;  
I will be with him in trouble,  
I will deliver him and honor him.
- 16 With long life I will satisfy him  
and show him my salvation."
